ALL bikes must have SPARK ARRESTORS (NO EXCEPTIONS) and NO OPEN FIRES AND/OR CHARCOAL GRILLS. Gas BBQ grills with the small propane bottles will be okay.
Do not show up without a spark arrestor, you will not be permitted to ride - PERIOD.
BLM staff will be at the event monitoring this requirement.

All vintage, twin-shock and modern bike support class riders are invited to attend. Turkey Rock is an excellent trials area in the south-central part of Colorado, located between Salida and Canon City. The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has designated the site as a "trials bikes with trials tires only" area. The site is located close to the Arkansas River, which is known for excellent fishing and river rafting. Wildlife is abundant within the area, especially bighorn sheep. Watch for them along the river and highway.

Burgers and hotdogs are provided for Saturday's dinner. Please bring a side-dish or something to share. BYOB.

All pets must be leashed. Primitive camping is available at no charge.

Driving directions:

From Salida, CO - Take US-50 East for approximately 12 miles; turn left on CR-4 toward Howard.

From Canon City, CO - Take US-50 West for approximately 45 miles; turn right on CR-4 toward Howard.

To Site: On CR-4 go .4 mile, turn right on to stay on CR-4 for another .1 mile. Turn right on CR-45; continue to Sand Road; turn left into the trials site (watch for ribbons and arrows).

BIG RIGS MUST ENTER THROUGH HOWARD DUE TO A LOW CLEARANCE RAILROAD BRIDGE.

Low clearance vehicles may turn on CR-47 (right from US-50 westbound/left from US-50 eastbound); proceed over the river and under the railroad bridge; turn left on CR-45; continue to Sand Road and turn right into the trials site.
