- ♣ 6:00 pm - Potluck cookout (bring your favorite main/side dish or treat to share)

Sunday ~

- ♣ 10:00 am - Trial starts at Lost Canyon Creek (plenty of parking available)
- ♣ 2:00 pm - Awards presentation (3 loops / 12 sections - short loop on Sunday)

**Driving directions:**

**From northbound I-25 take exit 49** - turn west, go over the hwy into town (road becomes Main St) about 1.4 miles. Turn left at Hwy 160 W/W7th St.

**From southbound I-25 take exit 52 toward Hwy 160 W (Walsenburg/Alamosa)** - Keep right at the fork & continue following the signs for Hwy 160 W, about 2.8 miles. Turn right at Hwy 160 W/W 7th St.

**Continue on Hwy 160 W just over 247 miles** – turn right on CO 184 W/N Main St. Go about 17.5 mile & turn right on CO 145 N/Railroad Ave. Central Ave is about 2 miles down the road.
