Mountain West Vintage Trials Association Tech Inspection Guidelines February 2013

Mt. West Vintage Trials Assoc. holds tech inspections for every event. Motorcycles are checked for safety and to ensure the requirements are met for the class entered.

Safety inspection will include:

- Chain sprockets
- Cables
- Kill switch or button
- Throttle works easily & returns on its own
- Brakes work easily
- Ball ends on levers
- Any sharp or exposed broken parts
- Spark arrestor for locations that require use of a spark arrestor
- Bar ends recommended

Bike Class inspection will include:

- Twin Shock classes
 - Air cooled
 - o Twin shocks
 - o Drum brakes
 - Cable operated controls
- Historic Single Shock
 - Air Cooled
 - o Mono shock
 - o Drum and/or single piston brakes
 - Cable operated clutch

MWVTA also offers a modern support class for bikes that don't meet the requirements for the other classes.

Any modifications made to a bike must be done in the spirit of the class you intend to ride it in.
